

2025 Campaigning Rules

1. The use of union stationery, supplies, or the IBEW logo by a candidate is forbidden.
2. The LU and its officers shall comply with a reasonable request to distribute campaign literature to the membership at the candidate's expense.
3. The LMRDA strictly forbids the use of union or employer funds to promote a particular candidate in a LU election. This prohibition includes any contributions of value by a union employer.
4. Candidates cannot campaign on paid company time or use a company's mailing system to campaign. Furthermore, using a company's copying machine without paying for its use is a violation of the LMRDA. This includes those employed by the LU.
5. Each bona fide candidate for office has a right, one time within 30 days prior to elections of which they are a candidate, to inspect a list containing the names, addresses, and phone numbers of voters of the LU. This does not include the right to copy the list but does include the right to compare it with a personal list of members.
6. A LU should not post any candidate's campaign literature on its website or social media pages. Candidates are free to create their own websites or social media

pages, but those websites or pages should not purport to be official sites of the local union or display the IBEW logo, which is a registered trademark.

7. Campaigning by, or on behalf of, any candidate will not be permitted inside the Union Hall during business hours or on JATC property, through Election Day June 7, 2025. Cards will be allowed inside the Union Hall on **tables** in the Front Lobby and on **tables** at the Side Entrance in front of the Dues Office window.
